



3. The Chairman advised the members that the Clerk's shredder was no longer functional. After considering the potential cost and type to be purchased, all agreed to a replacement being secured, the funding to come from the Clerk's imprest.

#### **4. Planning:**

##### **1. Applications:**

C06/0782/FUL Erection of single-storey side extension, 4, Eaton Close- supported.

C06/0791/FUL Erection of single-storey front and rear extensions, 5, Farriers Went - objected.

2. The Clerk read out a letter from a parishioner, requesting assistance with a problem. The members agreed that the matter was not within its domain and the author should seek legal advice. The Clerk was requested to write to the author accordingly.

3. No members subscribed to the David Lock presentation at the Suffolk Coastal District Council Offices, since the presentation would be the same as that which certain Councillors had already attended at the Spa. The Clerk agreed to pass on this information as a matter of courtesy.

4. Four documents received on the alterations to submissions for the Felixstowe Branch Line application were circulated. The Chairman read out the accompanying letter. B Frost requested that a second letter be written, maintaining the Council's objection, before the deadline date, being particularly concerned about the plans for the use of the single track between Trimley St. Martin and Levington, which discriminated against buses (the term not having been adequately defined either) and would entail buses stopping on the A14.

##### **5. Other Items Raised:**

1. C Storer stated that, since the Suffolk Coastal District Council's Options Report was anticipated in July, the Council should hold its normal monthly meeting in August on Monday, 7<sup>th</sup> with a public meeting, some time within the next fortnight after, to which Steve Brown of SCDC should be invited to comment and brief the Council on the report. All present agreed. The Clerk was asked to check Mr Brown's availability and Mrs B Shout agreed to look at the availability of the Welcome Hall for the public meeting.

6. All Councillors were requested to stay for an 'In camera' meeting.
